Wines by the Glass

White 1: Mont Gravet, Côtes de Gascogne, 2016, France. 175 ml
Aromatic and fresh, packed with aromas and flavours of citrus and
tropical fruits. Low alcohol. A good aperitif or companion to seafood.

White 2: Sauvignon Blanc, Gran Verano, Apaltagua, Chile. 175 ml
Citrus and grapefruit. Fresh and bright, which fits as Gran Verano
means “great summer” in Spanish.

White 3: San Valentin Parellada, Torres, Catalunya, Spain 175 ml glass.
Pineapple and tropical fruit notes. Off-dry with hints of well balanced
sweetness. Drink well chilled. Goes well with sunsets and Asian dishes.

Rosé 1: Culemborg Blanc de Noir, Western Cape, South Africa, 175 ml
Strawberries & cream aromas and a fresh, somewhat citrus finish.

Rosé 2: Mateus Rosé, Portugal. **250 ml**
Berry fruit nose. Light & fresh & just off-dry with a slight fizzy finish.

Red 1: Mont Gravet Carignan, 2016, France, 175 ml glass.
Aromas of blackberries and figs. This light, fruit-forward red has a
touch of spice and is easy drinking.

Red 2: Cabernet Sauvignon, Luis Felipe Edwards, **2017**, 175 ml glass.
Cherry, strawberry and cassis notes. Round and juicy tannins. Medium
bodied. This Chilean wine is well made and good value.

Champagne & Sparkling Wines

- C1 Champagne Moët & Chandon, Brut Imperial, NV, France. 750 ml** 1,375
Pale straw in colour, hints of flowers, vanilla, yeast and grapefruit. Delicate & fresh.
- C2 Champagne Laurent-Perrier, La Cuvée Brut, NV, France. Full-bottle, 750 ml** 1,195
Pale gold in colour. A delicate lemon shortbread nose. Soft creamed apples, lemon zest and toast flavours. Light and fruity. An elegant classic. **Half-bottle, 375 ml** 650
- C3 Champagne Ayala, Brut Majeur, NV, France, 375 ml half-bottle size** 600
This fresh and elegant champagne has notes of citrus, flowers and white fruits. It is well balanced and has a long finish.
- C4 Champagne Montvillers, Brut, NV, France. 750 ml** 895
A classic champagne, owned by Bollinger, with good fruit matched by a crisp, balancing acidity. Excellent value.
- C5 Champagne Ayala, Rosé Majeur, NV, France, 750 ml.** 1,195
Ayala, owned by Bollinger, produces fine champagne. Fresh and balanced, with mineral character and hints of mulberry, dried herb and toasted raisin bread.
- C6 Champagne Bollinger, La Grande Année, Brut, 2007, France.** 2,450
Barrel fermented and aged for eight years. A fine bouquet of ripe apricot and pink grapefruit along with chalky, toasty and almond/nougat notes. Elegant and complex on the palate. Full-bodied and well-structured with a long, intense yet dry, finish.
- C7 Crémant de Loire, Langlois Rosé, L'extra, NV, France.** 650
Salmon-pink in colour, light and delicious. A wild strawberry nose and flavours of raspberries and red fruit followed by a crisp apple finish.
- C8 Prosecco, Val D'Oca 'blue bottle' Millesimato, Extra dry, 2017, Italy.** 545
A good dry prosecco. Some biscuit complexity in the mouth. Round and fresh. Perfect for a hot afternoon.
- C9 Graham Beck Brut, Western Cape, South Africa.** 545
This blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay in the classic style yields a sparkling wine with yeasty aromas, limey fresh fruit and a rich creamy complexity. The fine mousse contributes to freshness, finesse and whiffs of minerality.
- C10 Swartland Cuvée Brut, Western Cape, South Africa.** 425
A refreshing sparkling wine with tropical fruit flavours and mineral hints. Not too dry, with fresh and crisp acidity. Tropical fruit, biscuit and nut flavours.

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White Wines

- W1 Sauvignon Blanc, Nederburg Reserve, Western Cape, 2018, South Africa. 455**
Crisp and medium-bodied, offering a delicious combination of tropical and herbaceous notes. Well balanced and with a lingering finish.
- W2 Sauvignon Blanc, Kia Ora, Marlborough, 2018, New Zealand. 475**
Supple and light. Passionfruit and nectarine on the nose. Appealing citrus and pear flavours and a note of green apple skin. Light-bodied. herbaceous notes. Perfect with fresh fish and lemon wedges.
- W3 Sauvignon Blanc, Moko Black, Marlborough, 2017, New Zealand. 545**
Zesty citrus with white stone fruits. Gooseberry hints roll into a full layered palate. Classically aromatic with texture and breadth.
- W4 Sauvignon Blanc, Cloudy Bay, Marlborough, 2019, New Zealand. 995**
A bright bouquet of lime, gooseberry and passion fruit. The palate offers passion fruit, citrus mousse and a fine mineral backbone. Refined, elegant and magnificent.
- W5 Chablis, J. Moreau et Fils, 2014, Burgandy, France 745**
An elegant nose of peach, pear and almond. The palate is fresh, balanced and creamy with notes of cherry blossom and citrus fruit zest. A complex wine with a long finish. A highly rated Chablis from an excellent vintage.
- W6 M. Antoine Geoffroy, Bourgogne Chardonnay Vieille Vignes, 2015, Burgundy 595**
Taut, full flavoured and showing nice lemony fruit with ripe cox apple notes and a hint of toast and minerality. Fruity & textured. Very well priced Burgundy.
- W7 Mâcon-La Roche Vineuse, Chanson, Mâconnais, Burgundy, 2015, France. 455**
Delicate floral and citrus fruit aromas on a hint of minerality. Well balanced and crisp. Classic Chardonnay, full and buttery with zesty notes. Excellent value.
- W8 Chanson Chassagne-Montrachet Chardonnay, Burgundy, 2014, France. 1,255**
Delicate floral fragrances mixed with citrus fruit aromas, pear and vanilla notes. Well structured, complex and with a beautiful texture. Very pure fruit. A long and pure finish with a hint of minerality.
- W9 Chardonnay, Santa Julia, 2017, Mendoza, Argentina, 375 ml. 230**
A fresh fruity Chardonnay, showing aromas of pear, pineapple and mango. Pairs well with pasta, seafood and fish. **Half-bottle size 375 ml**
- W10 Chardonnay, Nederburg, Winemasters, Western Cape, 2018, South Africa. 425**
Appealing aromas of lime, melon and vanilla open onto a fresh, creamy palate with a touch of citrus and apricot.
- W11 Terras Gauda, O Rosal, Rías Baixas, 2016, Spain. 595**
Floral aromatics, lush lemon and green apples on the nose. This Albariño blend is full bodied, structured and velvety. A dry, well rounded and highly respected wine.



- W12 Grüner Veltliner, Joseph Ehmoser, “von den Terrassen”, 2016, Austria. 455**
Green apple spritz and subtle spice notes. A fruity wine with peppery freshness and light herbaceous notes.
- W13 Hans Baer Riesling Trocken, Rheinhessen, Pfalz, 2017, Germany. 495**
Typical rich aromatics; apricot and white peach notes stand out. Juicy, light and fresh with lots of fruit. Balanced and crisp; a dry wine with a hint of residual **sweetness**.
- W14 Late Harvest, Luis Felipe Edwards, Colchagua Valley, 2015, Chile, 375 ml. 275**
Citrus aromas followed by intense apricot and peach flavours. Perfectly balanced acidity makes this a wine to enjoy with dessert, with fruit or sipped, well chilled, on its own whilst watching the sunset. **Sweet opulent pleasure. Half-bottle, 375 ml.**

Rosé Wine

- Rs1 Whispering Angel Rosé, Château d’Esclans, Provence, 2017, France. 750 ml 795**
A fresh and sculptured rosé with strawberry and cream character. On the mineral side of fruity, with a kick of mouthwatering salinity on the finish. Most enjoyable.
Half-bottle size (2018), 375 ml 455
- Rs2 Henri Gaillard, Côtes de Provence Rosé, 2018, France. 495**
Classic Provence rosé. Pale rose colour and notes of strawberry and raspberry on the nose. Good fruit, clean and balanced acidity. Dry with pleasant fruit hints.
- Rs3 Cuvée Sabourin Blush, Hérault, Languedoc, 2017, France. 395**
Light, fresh and fruity. Easy to drink in the sun with a mouth full of seafood.
- Rs4 Rosé d’Anjou Ch. De Montguéret, Loire Valley, 2018, France. 395**
Bouquet of ripe strawberries and plum fruit. Plenty of red fruit flavours. Soft, fresh and well balanced. Drink well chilled. Off Dry - expect **some fruity sweetness**.
- Rs5 Mateus Rosé, Sogrape, Dao, NV, Portugal. 355**
Berry fruit nose and red fruit flavours. Light & fresh & just off-dry. Well balanced flavours enhanced by the soft & slightly fizzy finish. Drink well chilled. A classic.

Red Wines

- R1 La Vieille Ferme Ventoux Rouge, Rhône Valley 2017, France. 435**
A red and black fruit nose with spice hints. The palate is fruity and velvety. Silky tannins, well balanced, and an aromatic finish. Excellent value.
- R2 Domaine Chanson Beaujolais-Villages, Burgundy, 2015, France. 545**
Bright ruby colour. Intense aromas of ripe red berries and liquorice notes. Supple and well structured. Light-bodied (Gamay grape), well balanced, and spicy nuances.





Red Wines

- R3 Felicité Pinot Noir, Newton Johnson, Hermanus, 2015, South Africa. 495**
Aromas packed with bright raspberry and plum, and fragrant spicy and earthy notes. Generous palate, round with chewy tannins and a juicy finish.
- R4 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Frentano, Abruzzo, 2015, Italy. 425**
Raspberry, cherry, plum and leather notes. Medium body. Notes of prune & vanilla. Soft acidity and gentle tannins. Sings with food. Excellent value.
- R5 Chaume Arnaud, Côtes du Rhône, 2015, France. 595**
Inviting nose, sweetly fruited with gamey / meaty hints. Ripe & juicy cherry, plum & cream on the palate with discreet spices. Dark chocolate hints and fine tannins.
- R6 Santa Julia Malbec, Mendoza, 2018, Argentina, 375 ml. 245**
Aromas of violets and ripe plums. Fruity character and deep colour. A smooth, easy going, and fruit-filled medium bodied wine. **Half-bottle size 375 ml**
- R7 La Firole-du-Pape, Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Rhone Valley, NV, France. 1,250**
The bottle is "buried pirate treasure". Floral nose with hints of leather and spice. Flavours of dried plum and vegetal notes. Medium-bodied. Chalky and spicy finish.
- R8 L'Atzar Priorat, Mas la Mola, Priorat, Catalunya, 2016, Spain. 525**
Fruity and bold. Blueberries, spices and well balanced tannins and acidity. Hints of licorice in the finish. Full-bodied, powerful and dark, yet easy drinking.
- R9 Château Clos Magne Figeac, St. Émilion, Bordeaux, 2013, France. 645**
Complex red fruit aromas, black cherry, plum and leather. with toasty and woody notes. A classic medium-bodied Bordeaux at an excellent price.
- R10 Villiera Cabernet Sauvignon, Stellenbosch, 2015, South Africa. 545**
A dark-berry and cassis nose with hints of spice and good body with some tannins adding grip. Smooth yet robust; well balanced.
- R11 Dona Bernarda Premium Blend, L.F. Edwards, Colchagua, 2011, Chile. 845**
Swirling aromas of blackberries, black currants, herbs, licorice and toasted oak. A savoury, full-bodied red with a long finish of warm spice and espresso.
- R12 Cederberg Shiraz, Citrusdal Mountain, 2016, South Africa. 785**
Intense red fruit, mulberry & cherries on the nose. Layers of flavour & complexity. Hints of sweet spice and vanilla. Red berries follow through on the palate and finishes off with a smooth lingering sensation. A well-crafted bold wine.
